^{*} If there is a risk of coming into contact with vomit and splashes from passengers, a face shield can be used instead of goggles. In general, the goggles and face shield are not used together at the same time. If the crew members of an international/regional flight cannot disinfect the goggles in time during their stay abroad, goggles shall be provided according to the flight sections.

- 1. Passenger area refers to an area where passengers stay, including passenger cabin, the observation area designated at an airport, and arrival area.
- 2. " \circ " in the table means that protective equipment is optional and can be selected as appropriate based on the actual exposure risk and conditions. " $\sqrt{}$ " means that protective equipment is mandatory.

^{**} Under special circumstances, the protective apron in the epidemic prevention bag can be used instead, as a short term emergency response.

^{***} Double layer disposable rubber gloves.

^{****} Cleaning staff are advised to wear long sleeves and trousers on high-risk flights to prevent skin exposure, and are recommended to wear goggles/protective screens when collecting medical wastes.
